- You believe that the proposed treatment facilities would not be in harmony with the neighborhood.
- You believe that this proposed use is not in the best interests of Bethlehem.
- You believe that there are other locations (e.g., 825 12th Avenue) better suited to this use.
- You believe that this proposed use is not a substantial improvement to property in the vicinity.
- You believe that this use is not appropriate with regard to the character of the general vicinity.
- You believe that, especially when combined with the approved 150 bed rehab facility at 825 12th Avenue, the proposed use if too large for the area.
